

Coronavirus Update

Dear Parents,

We continue to monitor the Coronavirus and all decisions about closure/early dismissal are being guided by recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, New York State Department of Health, the Nassau County Department of Health and the New York State Education Department. Our main goal is to provide a safe, calm and clean environment for your children.

Please find answers to frequently asked questions below:

1. Will our school close if other schools in the area close?

Our school will follow direction regarding school closings from the Nassau County Department of Health. If the Manhasset School District closes, we will close due to the proximity of our students and schools. If other districts close, they will not provide busing to our school so please be aware of area closures.

2. If OLG closes, how and when will be notified?

If it becomes necessary to close, we will send a text message, email and post the closure on our website. We will notify you as soon as possible.

3. What extra measures are being taken to provide for the safety of the children and staff?

Our school has been, and will continue to be, thoroughly cleaned daily. Teachers are cleaning classroom materials frequently. We are listening to and abiding by recommendations from the CDC and Department of Health.

4. If we are forced to close for an extended period are there plans in place to provide for continuity of instruction?

While we cannot replicate instruction that would normally be given during the school day, we are discussing ways to continue instruction and practice of lessons taught.

5. What can we all do to ensure the safety of our children?

The best way to prevent the Coronavirus is proper hygiene. This includes:

- Keep your child home when he/she is sick. We will be sending children home whom we deem to be unwell.
- Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Have your children sing a song while they are washing their hands.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Cough into your sleeve or a tissue.
